ENHANCED PRIMARY CAREPLANS (EPC)

WHAT IS AN EPC?

An EPC is a care plan arrangement between your GP and referred specialists.

Your GP will create your care plan according to your care needs. Remember to book in a long GP consult as there are forms you must complete.

HOW WILL I BENEFIT?

- Up to 5 Medicare rebates shared across all Allied Health in one year
- The current Medicare rebate is \$58.10 per session.
- Your GP will receive updated correspondence after each session
- **You can only use a maximum of 5 sessions per calendar year between specialists.**

Example: You may have 2 sessions for the Dietitian + 2 sessions for the Diabetes Educator + 1 session with the Exercise Physiologist. OR you GP may choose to select all 5 for Podiatry. Remember the 5 sessions are combined across all Allied Health.

FOR YOUR GP:

This patient has a chronic condition and may be eligible for an Enhanced Primary Careplan. The Careplan will allow a co-ordinated management plan with doctors and Allied Health Teams.
